Web App Updates v5.0.0 - Major Feature Release

Multi-Location Support (Select Tiers)

You can now manage products, storage areas, and barcodes across multiple locations—all in one place. This makes it easier to customize inventory counts for each site and speeds up setup by letting you copy settings from one location to another.

Why it matters:

Whether you have 2 locations or 20, inventory just got easier to manage and scale.

Serialized Inventory (Coming Soon!)

We've added the early groundwork for tracking individual items by serial number. While it's not fully active yet, you'll start to see hints of it in your Search, Count, Pick, and Receive features.

Why it matters:

This sets the stage for detailed item tracking, like managing warranties or tracing specific units in the future.
